HERE ARE SOME THINGS TO WATCH FOR

Any difficulty breathing

Repetitive cough

Wheezing

Widespread hives all over the body

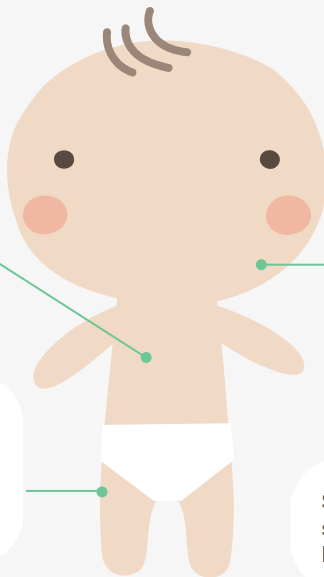
Change in skin color (pale or blue)

New rash/hives around the mouth or face

Lip, face or tongue swelling

Persistent vomiting/spitting up

Sudden tiredness/ seeming limp/ lethargic
